AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 709 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after "form;" insert "<u>requiring the Secretary to maintain certain</u> registration records in a certain manner that protects the identity of the registrant; authorizing the disclosure of certain registration records if the Secretary, after consulting with the Secretary of <u>Health and Mental Hygiene</u>, makes a certain determination;"; in line 11, strike "making certain records confidential;"; and in line 16, strike "3-806" and substitute "<u>3-805</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 18, after "PROGRAM" insert "<u>THAT IS</u>"; in line 19, after "DEALER" insert "<u>AND</u>"; strike beginning with the second "THE" in line 28 down through "REQUIRES" in line 30 and substitute "<u>:</u>

(1) THE NAME OF THE POULTRY KEEPER;

(2) THE LOCATION OF THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THE POULTRY IS

KEPT;

(3) THE TYPE OF POULTRY; AND

(4) ANY OTHER RELATED INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE <u>SECRETARY</u>";

and after line 30, insert:

"(C) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL MAINTAIN A PERSON'S REGISTRATION RECORD FILED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IN A MANNER THAT PROTECTS THE

(Over)

IDENTITY OF THE REGISTRANT.

(2) IF THE SECRETARY, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE, DETERMINES THAT THE DISCLOSURE IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR PREVENT THE SPREAD OF AN INFECTIOUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASE, THE SECRETARY MAY DISCLOSE A PERSON'S REGISTRATION RECORD.".

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 3 through 10, inclusive.
