AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 999

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “issued;” insert “providing for certain exceptions;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 21, after “(1)” insert “(I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH,”; and after line 24, insert:

“(II) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD BUT UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS MAY BE ISSUED A LICENSE FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 12 MONTHS IF:

1. UNDER § 10-506(A) OF THIS ARTICLE, A CERTIFICATE OF PERMISSION IS SOUGHT FOR THE CONTINUATION OF A BUSINESS ON THE DEATH OF THE HOLDER OF A LICENSE; OR

2. UNDER § 10-506(B) OF THIS ARTICLE, THE INDIVIDUAL IS A SURVIVING SPOUSE, A SURVIVING PARTNER ACTING FOR THE BENEFIT OF A PARTNERSHIP, OR THE SENIOR SURVIVING OFFICER ACTING FOR THE BENEFIT OF A CORPORATION.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 5, in line 8, after “(A-1)” insert “(1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION,”; and after line 9, insert:

“(2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD BUT UNDER THE AGE OF 21 YEARS MAY BE ISSUED A LICENSE FOR A PERIOD NOT EXCEEDING 12 MONTHS IF:

(Over)

(I) UNDER § 10-506(A) OF THIS ARTICLE, A CERTIFICATE OF PERMISSION IS SOUGHT FOR THE CONTINUATION OF A BUSINESS ON THE DEATH OF THE HOLDER OF A LICENSE; OR

(II) UNDER § 10-506(B) OF THIS ARTICLE, THE INDIVIDUAL IS A SURVIVING SPOUSE, A SURVIVING PARTNER ACTING FOR THE BENEFIT OF A PARTNERSHIP, OR THE SENIOR SURVIVING OFFICER ACTING FOR THE BENEFIT OF A CORPORATION.”.
