- 6 BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2006 IN A MANNER PROHIBITED UNDER § 14-3302(A) OF THIS
- 7 SUBTITLE MAY CONTINUE TO USE THE INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IN
- 8 THAT MANNER IF:
- 9 (1) THE USE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS 10 CONTINUOUS; AND
- 11 (2) BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2006, THE PERSON PROVIDES THE
- 12 INDIVIDUAL WITH AN ANNUAL DISCLOSURE FORM STATING THE INDIVIDUAL'S

- 24 or after January 1, 2006. Any health insurance policy or contract in effect before
- 25 January 1, 2006, shall comply with the provisions of this Act on or before January 1,
- 26 2007.
- 27 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 28 January 1, 2006. Section 2 of this Act shall remain in effect for a period of 3 years and,
- 29 at the end of December 31, 2008, with no further action required by the General
- 30 Assembly, Section 2 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
