Article - Labor and Employment

2 3-801. 3 In this subtitle, "employer" means a person engaged in a business, (a) 4 industry, profession, trade, or other enterprise in the State. 5 (b) "Employer" includes: a unit of State or local government that employs individuals who are 6 7 not subject to the provisions of Title 9, Subtitle 5 of the State Personnel and Pensions 8 Article; and (2) a person who acts directly or indirectly in the interest of another 10 employer with an employee. 11 3-802. 12 (a) This [subtitle] SECTION applies to an employer who provides leave with 13 pay to an employee following the birth of the employee's child. 14 3-803. THIS SECTION APPLIES TO AN EMPLOYER WHO PROVIDES VACATION 15 (A) 16 LEAVE TO AN EMPLOYEE. 17 AN EMPLOYER SHALL PROVIDE COMPENSATION, AT THE EMPLOYEE'S 18 REGULAR RATE OF PAY, FOR ANY UNUSED OR ACCUMULATED VACATION LEAVE 19 UPON ITS EXPIRATION.
