#### 1 AN ACT concerning

#### Department of Agriculture - Weights and Measures - Fees

### 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Agriculture
