19 (A) IN LIEU OF OR IN ADDITION TO ANY PENALTY PROVIDED BY THIS

20 SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY IMPOSE A <u>AN ADMINISTRATIVE</u> PENALTY <del>OF NOT</del>

- 1 MORE THAN \$10,000 ON ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS
- 2 SUBTITLE.
- 3 (B) THE PENALTY IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$10,000.
- 4 (C) ALL PENALTIES COLLECTED BY THE SECRETARY UNDER THIS SECTION
- 5 SHALL BE PAID INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
- 6 (C) (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT
- 7 NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 2005.
