## A BILL ENTITLED

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to impose an administrative penalty on any person who violates the commercial feed and fertilizer, agricultural liming materials, and pesticide registration and labeling laws; requiring certain penalties to be paid into the General Fund of the State; requiring the Secretary to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to the enforcement of the commercial feed and fertilizer, agricultural liming materials, and pesticide registration and labeling laws.

BY adding to Article - Agriculture
Section 5-107.1; and 6-401 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle
4. Administrative Penalties"

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article - Agriculture

(A) INSTEAD OF REFUSING OR CANCELLING A REGISTRATION, THE 2 SECRETARY MAY IMPOSE AN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY ON ANY PERSON WHO 3 VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE.
(B) THE PENALTY IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED \$2,000.
(C) ALL PENALTIES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

5 (A) INSTEAD OF REFUSING OR CANCELLING A REGISTRATION, THE 6 SECRETARY MAY IMPOSE AN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY ON ANY PERSON WHO 7 VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE.

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(B) THE PENALTY IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED $\$ 2,000$.
(C) ALL PENALTIES COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID INTO 10 THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

11 (D) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO 12 IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
