3 (A) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF 4 MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE RECEIVE THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO:

5 (1) OPERATE AS MARYLAND'S OPEN UNIVERSITY SERVING
6 NONTRADITIONAL STUDENTS WHO RESIDE IN MARYLAND, THE UNITED STATES, AND

1 [(c)] (E) [University College] THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY

2 COLLEGE shall prepare an annual financial information statement for the next
