
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By: Delegates Boschert, Frush, Menes, and Moe Introduced and read first time: January 14, 2005 Assigned to: Appropriations Committee Report: Favorable with amendments House action: Adopted Read second time: March 1, 2005 CHAPTER____ 1 AN ACT concerning 2 Higher Education - University of Maryland University College - Governing 3 **Authority** FOR the purpose of establishing that the University of Maryland University College is an instrumentality of the State; providing that the exercise of certain powers 5 by the University of Maryland University College is for a certain purpose; 6 establishing that the Maryland Tort Claims Act applies to certain claims or 7 actions against the University of Maryland University College under certain 8 9 circumstances; providing that the sovereign immunity of the University of 10 Maryland University College is not waived under certain circumstances; authorizing a custodian to deny inspection of certain public records pertaining to 11 the University of Maryland University College; prohibiting a custodian from 12 denying inspection of certain public records relating to the University of 13 Maryland University College under certain circumstances; declaring the intent 14 15 of the General Assembly; clarifying the name of a certain institution; and 16 generally relating to the governing authority and operations of the University of 17 Maryland University College. - 3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 4 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 5 Article Education
- 6 13-101.
- 7 (A) IT IS THE INTENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT THE UNIVERSITY OF 8 MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE RECEIVE THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO:
- 9 (1) OPERATE AS MARYLAND'S OPEN UNIVERSITY SERVING
- 10 NONTRADITIONAL STUDENTS WHO RESIDE IN MARYLAND, THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 11 THROUGHOUT THE WORLD;
- 12 (2) PROVIDE THE CITIZENS OF MARYLAND WITH AFFORDABLE, OPEN
- 13 ACCESS HIGHER EDUCATION; AND
- 14 (3) CONTINUE AS A LEADER IN DISTRIBUTED HIGHER EDUCATION.
- 15 [(a)] (B) (1) There is a [University College in the University of Maryland]
- 16 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE which is not a new [branch]
- 17 CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION of the University SYSTEM of Maryland.
- 18 (2) AS A CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF
- 19 MARYLAND, THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE IS AN
- 20 INSTRUMENTALITY OF THE STATE AND A UNIT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.
- 21 (3) THE EXERCISE BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY
- 22 COLLEGE OF ITS CONFERRED POWERS, INCLUDING ITS OVERSEAS OPERATIONS, IS
- 23 THE PERFORMANCE OF AN ESSENTIAL PUBLIC FUNCTION.
- 24 [(b)] (C) The provisions of § 12-105(a) of this article do not apply to the
- 25 overseas operations of [University College, University College] THE UNIVERSITY OF
- 26 MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE. THE INSTITUTION may spend the appropriation
- 27 without the approval of the Board of Public Works and without submitting a detailed
- 28 budget schedule to the Board of Public Works.
- 29 (D) (1) TITLE 12, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE
- 30 ("MARYLAND TORT CLAIMS ACT") APPLIES TO CLAIMS OR ACTIONS AGAINST THE
- 31 UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE AND ITS EMPLOYEES.
- 32 (2) SUBJECT TO ALL EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS IN THAT SUBTITLE.
- 33 THE IMMUNITY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE IS
- 34 WAIVED TO THE EXTENT OF ANY APPLICABLE LIABILITY INSURANCE PURCHASED BY
- 35 THE UNIVERSITY OR THE STATE TREASURER.
