1 AN ACT concerning

2 ~~Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2003~~ Community Based
3 Regional Initiatives Loan of 2004 - Baltimore City - Baltimore Center for
4 Children

5 FOR the purpose of amending ~~Chapter 290 of the Acts of 2002, as amended by~~
6 ~~Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003~~ the Community Based Regional Initiatives Loan
7 of 2004, to change the location of the Baltimore Center for Children to a certain
8 location in Baltimore City; removing the requirement that the proceeds are to be
9 used for providing handicapped access, a sprinkler system, elevators, an HVAC
10 system, and interior walls to provide separate rooms; making this Act an
11 emergency measure; and generally relating to the financing of certain capital
12 projects.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

4 (3) (G) Baltimore Center for Children. Provide a grant equal to
 5 the lesser of (i) \$400,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund
 6 provided, to the Board of Directors of the Baltimore Child Abuse
 7 Center, Inc. for the construction, renovation, and capital
 8 equipping of the new Baltimore Center for Children building [to
 9 include handicapped access, a sprinkler system, elevators, an
 10 HVAC system, and interior walls to provide separate rooms,]
 11 located [at 2315 St. Paul Street] AT 2300 NORTH CHARLES
 12 STREET in Baltimore CITY, subject to the requirement that the
 13 grantee grant and convey an historic easement to the Maryland
 14 Historical Trust. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section
 15 12(5) of this Act, the matching fund may include real property
 16 or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act
 17 (Baltimore City)400,000

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an
 19 emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
 20 or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the
 21 members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take
 22 effect from the date it is enacted.
