- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL OR A COUNTY FIRE MARSHAL MAY REQUIRE THE
- 17 USE OF MATERIALS THAT ARE FIRE RESISTANT, FIRE RETARDANT, OR
- 18 NONCOMBUSTIBLE:
- 19 ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS; AND
- 20 (2) FOR A STRUCTURE PLANNED:
