	(A) A VENDOR OF NEWLY CONSTRUCTED RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY SHALL COMPLETE AND PRESENT TO THE PURCHASER, AT SETTLEMENT, A HOUSE LOCATION PLAT.
