## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2	St. Mary's County - Agricultural Land Preservation Program - General
3	<b>Obligation Installment Purchase Agreements</b>
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4 I 5	FOR the purpose of authorizing and empowering the County Commissioners of St.
	Mary's County, from time to time, to enter into installment purchase
6 7	agreements for an aggregate purchase price of not more than \$20,000,000, plus
8	interest thereon, to acquire under certain criteria transfer development rights in tracts or parcels of agricultural and forestry land located in St. Mary's County,
o 9	Maryland as part of the County's Agricultural Land Preservation Program;
9 10	empowering the County to fix and determine under certain criteria, by
10	resolution, the tracts or parcels of land the transfer development rights of which
12	are to be acquired and the form, content, terms and conditions of each
12	installment purchase agreement, including, without limitation, the purchase
14	price payable thereunder, the maturity date of the installment purchase
15	agreement, the interest rate and the schedule of payments of the purchase price
16	(or the method of determining such interest rate and payment schedule) and all
17	other details incident to the acquisition of the development rights and the
18	installment purchase agreements; providing that the County's obligation to
19	make payments of the purchase price under the installment purchase
20	agreements and to pay interest thereon shall be a general obligation of the
21	County made upon its full faith and credit; empowering and directing the
22	County to levy, impose, and collect, annually, ad valorem taxes in rate and
23	amount sufficient to provide funds for the payment of the maturing purchase
24	price of and interest on the installment purchase agreements; exempting the
25	installment purchase agreements and the interest thereon and any income
26	derived therefrom from all State, county, municipal, and other taxation in the
27	State of Maryland; authorizing and empowering the County to purchase and set
28	aside in a segregated fund or account U.S. Treasury STRIPs or other
29	investments allowed under certain provisions of the law and the investment
30	guidelines of St. Mary's County to pay the balance of the purchase price of the
31	installment purchase agreements payable on their maturity dates; and
32	generally relating to the County's entering into installment purchase
33	agreements to acquire transfer development rights in agricultural and forestry
34	lands in St. Mary's County.

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1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

2 MARYLAND, That, as used herein, the term "County" means the body politic and

3 corporate of the State of Maryland known as the County Commissioners of St. Mary's

4 County; and the term "Installment Purchase Agreement" means an agreement

5 pursuant to which the County will acquire transfer development rights in one or more

6 tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry land located in St. Mary's County,

7 Maryland from the owners thereof, will pay the purchase price for that land either in

8 installments or at the maturity of the Installment Purchase Agreement and will pay

9 interest on the unpaid balance of that purchase price.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into Installment Purchase Agreements for an 11 12 aggregate purchase price of not more than \$20,000,000, plus interest thereon, to 13 acquire transfer development rights in tracts or parcels of agricultural and forestry 14 land located in St. Mary's County, Maryland as part of the County's Agricultural Land 15 Preservation Program. The County's obligation to make payments of the purchase price under each Installment Purchase Agreement and to pay interest on the unpaid 16 balance of the purchase price under each Installment Purchase Agreement shall be a 17 general obligation of the County and shall be made upon its full faith and credit, and 18 19 shall be evidenced by the Installment Purchase Agreement.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County shall select 20 the tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry land for which transfer development 21 rights are to be acquired and shall negotiate the purchase price for such transfer 22 23 development rights and all other terms and conditions of the Installment Purchase Agreement with the owner or owners of such property, all in accordance with the 24 25 County's Agricultural Land Preservation Program as in effect from time to time. In 26 selecting the tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry land for purposes of acquiring 27 transfer development rights, the County shall to the extent possible select 28 agricultural or forestry land equitably among the County election districts that are 29 set by the County Commissioners. 30 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That each Installment

31 Purchase Agreement shall be entered into in accordance with a resolution of the County, which shall provide for the acquisition of the transfer development rights in 32 one or more specified particular tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry land 33 located in St. Mary's County, Maryland which is to be the subject of the Installment 34 Purchase Agreement. In acquiring the transfer development rights in tracts or parcels 35 of agricultural or forestry land located in the County, the County shall to the extent 36 possible acquire agricultural or forestry land equitably among the County election 37 38 districts that are set by the County Commissioners. The County shall have and is hereby granted full and complete authority and discretion in the resolution to specify 39 40 the tracts or parcels of agricultural or forestry land the transfer development rights of 41 which are to be acquired and to provide and approve the form, tenor and content of 42 the Installment Purchase Agreement described in the resolution, including, without 43 limitation, (a) the designation, (b) the date, (c) the purchase price thereunder (or the 44 maximum purchase price and the method of determining the final purchase price 45 subject to such limitation), (d) the maturity date of the Installment Purchase

46 Agreement (not exceeding 30 years from the date of execution and delivery of the

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1 Installment Purchase Agreement) on which the final balance of the purchase price is 2 payable, (e) whether any portion of the purchase price will be payable prior to the 3 maturity date of the Installment Purchase Agreement, and, if so, the dates of 4 payments of any installments of the purchase price and the amounts of such 5 installments (or the methods or formula for determining such installment dates and amounts), (f) the interest rate per annum (or the method of determining such rate) 6 payable on the Installment Purchase Agreement from time to time and the dates for 7 payment of such interest, (g) the terms and conditions, if any, under which the 8 9 Installment Purchase Agreement may or shall be redeemed prior to its maturity date, 10 (h) provisions relating to the registration and transfer of the Installment Purchase Agreement, (i) the required signatures on the Installment Purchase Agreement and 11 all related documents, (j) the appointment of a paying agent and registrar for the 12 13 Installment Purchase Agreement, which may be the Director of Administration and 14 Finance of the County, any other employee of the County, any department of the 15 County government or any bank or trust company within or without the State of 16 Maryland having corporate trust powers, (k) covenants relating to compliance with applicable requirements of federal income tax law, including (without limitation) 17 covenants regarding the payment of rebate or penalties in lieu of rebate, and (1) 18 generally all matters incident to the acquisition of the transfer development rights 19

20 and the terms, conditions, execution and delivery of the Installment Purchase

21 Agreement.

22 Each Installment Purchase Agreement may be made redeemable before maturity, at the option of the County, at such price or prices and under such terms 23 and conditions as may be fixed by the County prior to the execution and delivery of 24 25 the Installment Purchase Agreement. The Installment Purchase Agreement shall be in registered form. In case any officer whose signature appears on any bond or on any 26 coupon attached thereto ceases to be such officer before the delivery thereof, such 27 signature shall nevertheless be valid and sufficient for all purposes as if he or she had 28 29 remained in office until such delivery. Any Installment Purchase Agreements entered 30 into from time to time under the authority of this Act shall be specifically exempt 31 from the provisions of Article 31, §§ 9, 10, and 11 of the Annotated Code of Maryland. 32 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Installment Purchase

Agreements hereby authorized shall constitute, and they shall be so recite, an 33 irrevocable pledge of the full faith and credit and unlimited taxing power of the 34 35 County to the payment of the maturing purchase price under the Installment Purchase Agreements and the interest on the unpaid balance of that purchase price 36 as and when they become payable. In each and every year until all of the purchase 37 price payable under the Installment Purchase Agreements and the interest thereon 38 are paid in full, the County shall levy or cause to be levied ad valorem taxes on all the 39 40 assessable property within the corporate limits of the County in rate and amount 41 sufficient, together with any recordation tax revenues designated for such payments 42 and other available funds, to provide for or assure the payment, when due, of the 43 purchase price of all outstanding Installment Purchase Agreements and the interest 44 thereon maturing in each such fiscal year and, in the event the proceeds from the 45 taxes so levied in any such fiscal year shall prove inadequate for such payment, 46 additional taxes shall be levied in the succeeding fiscal year to make up any such 47 deficiency. The County may apply to the payment of the purchase price of the

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1 outstanding Installment Purchase Agreements and interest payable thereon any

2 funds received by it from the State of Maryland, the United States of America, or any

3 agency or instrumentality thereof, or from any other source, if such funds are granted

4 for the purpose of assisting the County in financing the acquisition of transfer

5 development rights in agricultural or forestry land located in St. Mary's County,

6 Maryland and to the extent of any such funds received or receivable in any fiscal year,

7 the taxes that are required to be levied may be reduced accordingly.

8 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the County is authorized 9 and empowered to purchase and set aside in a segregated fund or account U.S. 10 Treasury STRIPs or other obligations allowed under Article 95, §§ 22, 22F, and 22G of 11 the Annotated Code of Maryland (or any successor provision of law) and the County's 12 guidelines, as in effect from time to time. It is intended that investments in that 13 segregated fund or account will be applied to the payment of the balance of the 14 purchase price of the Installment Purchase Agreements on their respective maturity 15 dates; but the investments shall not be pledged to the payment of the purchase price 16 of any of the Installment Purchase Agreements or the interest thereon, and no person 17 other than the County shall have any interest therein.

18 SECTION 7. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That any and all Installment 19 Purchase Agreements entered into by the County pursuant to the authority of this 20 Act, their transfer, the interest payable thereon, and any income derived therefrom in 21 the hands of the registered owners thereof from time to time (including any profit 22 made in the sale thereof) shall be and are hereby declared to be at all times exempt 23 from State, county, municipal, or other taxation of every kind and nature whatsoever 24 within the State of Maryland.

25 SECTION 8. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the authority conferred 26 on the County by this Act to enter into Installment Purchase Agreements and create 27 debt of the County shall be deemed to provide an additional and alternative authority 28 for borrowing money and creating debt and shall be regarded as supplemental and 29 additional to powers conferred on the County by other laws and shall not be regarded as in derogation of any power now existing; and all Acts of the General Assembly of 30 Maryland heretofore passed authorizing the County to borrow money and incur debt 31 32 are hereby continued to the extent that the powers contained in those prior Acts have not been exercised, and nothing contained in this Act may be construed to impair, in 33 34 any way, the validity of any bonds or other obligations that may have been entered 35 into by the County under the authority of any of said Acts, and the validity of the 36 bonds or other obligations is hereby ratified, confirmed, and approved. This Act, being 37 necessary for the welfare of the inhabitants of St. Mary's County, shall be liberally 38 construed to effect the purposes hereof. All Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with 39 the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

40 SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 41 June 1, 2005.
