A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - Public Schools - Use of Sunscreen**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a public school or public school system from
4 preventing a student from applying sunscreen in a certain manner before
5 engaging in outdoor school activities; and generally relating to the application of
6 sunscreen by students at public schools.

10 Annotated Code of Maryland

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Education**

15 7-421.

16 A PUBLIC SCHOOL OR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM MAY NOT PROHIBIT A STUDENT
17 FROM APPLYING SUNSCREEN IN A SAFE AND PROPER MANNER BEFORE ENGAGING
18 IN OUTDOOR SCHOOL ACTIVITIES.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 2005.
