- 17 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, this section governs the
- 18 overtaking and passing of vehicles going in the same direction.
- 19 (b) The driver of a vehicle overtaking another vehicle that is going in the same
- 20 direction shall pass to the left of the overtaken vehicle at a safe distance.
- 21 (c) The driver of a vehicle overtaking another vehicle that is going in the same
- 22 direction, until safely clear of the overtaken vehicle, may not drive any part of [his]
- 23 THE DRIVER'S vehicle directly in front of the overtaken vehicle.
- 24 (d) Except when overtaking and passing on the right is permitted, the
- 25 driver of an overtaken vehicle, on audible signal, shall give way to the right in favor
- 26 of the overtaking vehicle.
