- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 3 (C) THE GOVERNING BODY OF A REGIONAL HIGHER EDUCATION CENTER MAY
- 4 SUBMIT A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE OFFERING OF A BACCALAUREATE
- 5 DEGREE PROGRAM AT THE CENTER IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 16-108 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 6 16-108.
- 7 (A) (1) A BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSION A
- 8 REOUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE OFFERING OF A BACCALAUREATE DEGREE
- 9 PROGRAM NOT CURRENTLY OFFERED IN THE REGION.
- 10 (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE REQUEST FOR
- 11 PROPOSALS TO PUBLIC SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS AND NONPUBLIC
- 12 INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.
- 13 (B) BEFORE SUBMITTING A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS UNDER SUBSECTION
- 14 (A) OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL:
- 15 (1) SEEK INPUT FROM STUDENTS, WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
- 16 COUNCILS, AND OTHER CIVIC, EDUCATIONAL, COMMUNITY, AND BUSINESS GROUPS

- 26 PROPOSALS TO AN OUT-OF-STATE SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION
- 27 <u>INSTITUTIONS</u> IF NONE OF THE SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS IN THE
- 28 STATE RESPOND SUBMIT AN ACCEPTABLE RESPONSE TO THE REQUEST FOR
- 29 PROPOSALS SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- 30 (2) BEFORE OFFERING A DEGREE PROGRAM THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF
- 31 THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS, AN OUT-OF-STATE SENIOR HIGHER EDUCATION
- 32 INSTITUTION SHALL SEEK THE APPROVAL OF THE COMMISSION UNDER TITLE 11,
- 33 SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- 34 (D) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THE
- 35 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
