A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Knights of St. John Hall

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of
- 4 \$250,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of Knights
- of St. John Hall, Inc. for certain development or improvement purposes;
- 6 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds; prohibiting the use of the loan
- 7 proceeds for religious purposes; establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or
- 8 expenditure of the loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and
- 9 sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

- 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Prince
- 14 George's County Knights of St. John Hall Loan of 2005 in the total principal amount
- 15 of \$250,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State
- 16 general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and
- 17 issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State
- 18 Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 20 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 21 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 23 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 24 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 25 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the
- 26 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 27 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Trustees of Knights of St.
- 28 John Hall, Inc. for the repair, renovation, and capital equipping of the historic
- 29 meeting hall of the Knights of St. John, located in Bowie.
- 30 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in
- 31 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and

- 1 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 2 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 3 (5) No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be
- 4 used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the
- 5 design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of
- 6 sectarian religious worship or instruction, or in connection with any program or
- 7 department of divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board
- 8 of Public Works, the grantee shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none
- 9 of the proceeds of the loan or any matching funds have been or are being used for a
- 10 purpose prohibited by this Act.
- 11 (6) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 12 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2012. If any
- 13 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,
- 14 2012, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be
- 15 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the
- 16 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as
- 17 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 June 1, 2005.
