



1 (c) The employer's share for State retirement and pension contributions made  
2 on behalf of the Chairman and other Board members may not be considered  
3 compensation for the purpose of calculating compensation under subsection (a) of this  
4 section.

5 (d) (1) The Chairman and other Board members may participate in health  
6 insurance and other benefit programs sponsored by the Board.

7 (2) A Board member's participation in a benefit program sponsored by  
8 the Board under this subsection may not be considered compensation for the purpose  
9 of calculating compensation under subsection (a) of this section.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11 July 1, 2005.
