- 3 (a) The Chairman of the County Board is entitled to receive \$14,000 annually 4 as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive \$12,000 each annually 5 as compensation.
- 6 (b) [The] AFTER SUBMITTING VOUCHERS UNDER THE RULES AND 7 REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COUNTY BOARD, THE Chairman and the other 8 members are entitled to [the allowances] RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT for travel and
- 9 other expenses AS provided in the Howard County budget.
- 10 (c) The employer's share for State retirement and pension contributions made
- 11 on behalf of the Chairman and other Board members may not be considered
- 12 compensation for the purpose of calculating compensation under subsection (a) of this

- 14 (d) (1) The Chairman and other Board members may participate in health 15 insurance and other benefit programs sponsored by the Board.
