- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Department of the Environment to
- 4 provide property owners located within a certain distance of a site found to be
- 5 contaminated with a certain amount of methyl tertiary butyl ether with a
- 6 certain notice; requiring a person responsible for a certain oil spillage to be
- 7 liable for the costs to the Department of providing a certain notice; defining a
- 8 certain term; and generally relating to notifying the public of the presence of
- 9 methyl tertiary butyl ether.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article - Environment

- 19 (a) The person responsible for the oil spillage shall be liable [to]:
- 20 (1) TO any other person for any damage to his real or personal property
- 21 directly caused by the spillage; AND
- 22 (2) TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING
- 23 THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.
- 24 (b) (1) In this subsection, "owner of an underground oil storage tank"
- 25 includes any person who:

- 24 1. THE AMOUNT OF MTBE CONTAMINATION AT THE SITE;
- 25 2. THE ACTIONS THE DEPARTMENT IS TAKING TO ADDRESS
- 26 THE CONTAMINATION; AND
- 27 3. THE ACTIONS THAT THE PROPERTY OWNER SHOULD
- 28 TAKE TO PROTECT THE OWNER'S HEALTH AND PROPERTY.
- 29 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 30 October 1, 2005.
