A BILL ENTITLED

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- Creation of a State Debt Anne Arundel County Annapolis and Anne
 Arundel County Conference and Visitors Bureau
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed \$500,000,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Annapolis and
- 6 Anne Arundel County Conference and Visitors Bureau for certain development
- 7 or improvement purposes; providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds,
- 8 subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend a matching fund;
- 9 establishing a deadline for the encumbrance or expenditure of the loan proceeds;
- requiring the grantee to grant and convey a certain easement to the Maryland
- Historical Trust; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds
- evidencing the loan.
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That:
- 15 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 16 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Anne Arundel
- 17 County Annapolis and Anne Arundel County Conference and Visitors Bureau Loan
- 18 of 2005 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$500,000 or (ii) the
- 19 amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This
- 20 loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation
- 21 bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 22 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 23 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 24 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as
- 25 a single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under
- 26 § 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 27 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer
- 28 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and
- 29 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then
- 30 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the

- 1 Board of Public Works, for the following public purposes, including any applicable
- 2 architects' and engineers' fees: as a grant to the Board of Directors of the Annapolis
- 3 and Anne Arundel County Conference and Visitors Bureau (referred to hereafter in
- 4 this Act as "the grantee") for the planning, design, construction, renovation, and
- 5 reconstruction of the Annapolis and Anne Arundel County Conference and Visitors
- 6 Bureau Center, located in Annapolis.
- 7 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in 8 rate and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as and 9 when due and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years 10 after the date of issuance of the bonds.
- 11 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 12 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a
- 13 matching fund. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either
- 14 directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
- 15 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property. No part of the fund may
- 16 consist of in kind contributions or funds expended prior to the effective date of this
- 17 Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or
- 18 assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the
- 19 matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 2007, to
- 20 present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will
- 21 be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and
- 22 the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan
- 23 equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided
- 24 in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund
- 25 certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.
- 26 (6) The proceeds of the loan must be expended or encumbered by the Board of
- 27 Public Works for the purposes provided in this Act no later than June 1, 2012. If any
- 28 funds authorized by this Act remain unexpended or unencumbered after June 1,
- 29 2012, the amount of the unencumbered or unexpended authorization shall be
- 30 canceled and be of no further effect. If bonds have been issued for the loan, the
- 31 amount of unexpended or unencumbered bond proceeds shall be disposed of as
- 32 provided in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 33 (7) (a) Prior to the issuance of the bonds, the grantee shall grant and convey
- 34 to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement to the extent of
- 35 its interest:
- 36 (i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
- 37 and
- 38 (ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic
- 39 structures.
- 40 (b) If the grantee or beneficiary of the grant holds a lease on the land
- 41 and structures, the Trust may accept an easement on the leasehold interest.

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- 1 (c) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust 2 and any liens or encumbrances against the land or the structures must be acceptable
- 3 to the Trust.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 June 1, 2005.
