- 15 under § 13-809(a) of the Transportation Article as enacted under Section 1 of this Act
- 16 does not apply until any Consolidated Transportation Bonds that were issued by the
- 17 Department of Transportation before July 1, 2005 no longer remain outstanding and
- 18 unpaid; provided, however, that in any fiscal year for which funds are appropriated by
- 19 the General Assembly to pay the principal of and interest on the Department of
- 20 Transportation's Consolidated Transportation Bonds due and payable in that fiscal
- 21 year, the Motor Vehicle Administration shall collect the reduced motor vehicle excise
- 22 tax imposed on a vehicle by utilizing the modified definition as enacted under Section
