1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Vehicle Laws - Provisional Driver's License Restriction for a Minor -**  
3 **Prohibition Against Minors as Passengers**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to impose a certain  
5 restriction on the original provisional driver's license of a minor that prohibits  
6 the minor from transporting individuals under a certain age as passengers;  
7 requiring the restriction to be in effect for a certain period of time; exempting  
8 certain passengers from the provisions of this Act; authorizing a police officer to  
9 enforce a violation of a restriction imposed under this Act only as a secondary  
10 violation; providing that a violation of a restriction imposed under this Act is a  
11 moving violation for the purpose of assessing points against a driver's license;  
12 and generally relating to a restriction on the original provisional driver's license  
13 of a minor.

3 (D-2) (1) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II)2 OF THIS  
4 PARAGRAPH, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL IMPOSE ON EACH PROVISIONAL DRIVER'S  
5 LICENSE ISSUED TO A LICENSEE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS A RESTRICTION THAT  
6 PROHIBITS THE LICENSEE FROM DRIVING A MOTOR VEHICLE WITH A PASSENGER  
7 UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS.

8 (II) THE RESTRICTION IMPOSED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF  
9 THIS PARAGRAPH:

10 1. SHALL BE IN EFFECT FROM THE DATE THE PROVISIONAL  
11 LICENSE IS ORIGINALLY ISSUED UNTIL THE 181ST DAY AFTER THE PROVISIONAL  
12 LICENSE WAS ISSUED; AND

13 2. DOES NOT APPLY TO A PASSENGER WHO IS:

14 A. A SPOUSE, DAUGHTER, SON, STEPDAUGHTER, STEPSON,  
15 SISTER, BROTHER, STEPSISTER, OR STEPBROTHER OF THE LICENSEE; OR

16 B. A RELATIVE OF THE LICENSEE WHO RESIDES AT THE  
17 SAME ADDRESS AS THE LICENSEE.

18 (2) A POLICE OFFICER MAY ENFORCE A RESTRICTION IMPOSED UNDER  
19 THIS SUBSECTION ONLY AS A SECONDARY ACTION WHEN THE POLICE OFFICER  
20 DETAINS A DRIVER FOR A SUSPECTED VIOLATION OF ANOTHER PROVISION OF THE  
21 CODE.

22 (3) A VIOLATION OF A RESTRICTION IMPOSED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION  
23 IS A MOVING VIOLATION FOR THE PURPOSES OF § 16-402 OF THIS TITLE.
