representation with the intent to represent that the person practices licensed
 practical nursing.

3 (e) Unless authorized to practice as a nursing graduate under this title, a 4 person may not use the words "nursing graduate", the abbreviation "NG", or any 5 other title, symbol, abbreviation, sign, card, device, or other representation with the 6 intent to represent that the person practices as a nursing graduate.

- 2 October 1, 2005 is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate
 3 preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote
- 4 supported by three-fifths of all of the members elected to each of the two Houses of
- 5 the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
