- 5 (b) (1) The director of a medical laboratory located in this State shall submit 6 a report to the health officer for the county where the laboratory is located within 48
- 7 hours after an examination of a human specimen shows evidence of any disease or
- 8 condition listed in subsection (c) of this section.
- 9 (2) The director of a medical laboratory located outside of this State that
- 10 performs a medical laboratory test on a human specimen acquired from a person in
- 11 this State shall submit a report to the Secretary within 48 hours after an examination
- 12 of that specimen shows evidence of any disease or condition listed in subsection (c) of
