BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings** 16 2-309. The Sheriff of Howard County shall receive an annual salary as 17 (o) (1) (i) 18 follows: 19 1. [\$54,101 for calendar year 2001;

1 3. \$62,000 for calendar year 2003; 2 4. \$63,500 for calendar year 2004; 3 5.] \$65,000 for calendar year 2005; [and 4 6.] 2. \$66,500 for calendar year 2006 [and thereafter.]; 5 3. \$77,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2007; 4. \$80,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2008; 6 7 5. \$82,500 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2009; AND 8 6. \$85,000 FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2010. 9 The Sheriff shall appoint the number of deputies authorized by (ii) 10 the county government. The compensation of the deputies shall be set by the county government. A deputy holds office at the pleasure of the Sheriff and may be removed 12 by the Sheriff at any time or by the Circuit Court for Howard County upon indictment 13 and conviction as provided by law. The Sheriff may appoint additional temporary 14 deputy sheriffs when necessary for the public safety and the county government shall 15 allow them reasonable compensation. These deputies may not serve longer than the 16 case actually requires. 17 (2) The primary duties of the Sheriff are the following: 18 The security of the circuit court, and the performance of such (i) 19 duties as may be required of them by that court; 20 The service of process of writs, summonses, orders, petitions, (ii) 21 subpoenas, warrants, orders to show cause, and other legal papers; and 22. (iii) Additional duties, including law enforcement as may be 23 requested by law enforcement or other criminal justice agencies, the circuit court, or the county government, when necessary for the public safety. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, § 25 26 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to 27 the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Howard County in office on the effective 28 date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or compensation 29 of the Sheriff of Howard County shall take effect at the beginning of the next 30 following term of office.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
