IF A COUNTY BOARD REQUIRES A RETIRED PRINCIPAL, TEACHER, OR OTHER
CERTIFICATED OR NONCERTIFICATED EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNTY BOARD TO HAVE
COMPLETED A SPECIFIED NUMBER OF YEARS OF SERVICE BEFORE BEING ELIGIBLE
FOR HEALTH BENEFITS, THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL INCLUDE THE NUMBER OF
YEARS IN WHICH THE RETIRED PRINCIPAL, TEACHER, OR OTHER CERTIFICATED OR
NONCERTIFICATED EMPLOYEE HAS BEEN A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS'
RETIREMENT SYSTEM, THE TEACHERS' PENSION SYSTEM, THE EMPLOYEES'
RETIREMENT SYSTEM, OR THE EMPLOYEES' PENSION SYSTEM UNDER TITLE 22 OR 23
OF THE STATE PERSONNEL AND PENSIONS ARTICLE AND THE COUNTY'S
