1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Department of Agriculture - Water Pollution Control - Cost Sharing**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the requirement that a certain person pay the full
 4 amount of State cost sharing funds paid for certain practices; authorizing the
 5 Department of Agriculture to determine the amount that a certain person shall
 6 pay for failing to establish or maintain a certain practice; making a stylistic
 7 change; and generally relating to cost sharing under the Department's voluntary
 8 cost sharing program for water pollution control.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Agriculture**

17 8-705.

18 (a) Failure by a person to establish, install, construct, or maintain a best
 19 management practice in accordance with the agreement required to be executed with
 20 the Department [of Agriculture] under § 8-704 of this subtitle shall render the
 21 person liable for [the full] AN amount, TO BE DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, of
 22 State cost sharing funds paid for practices that are not implemented or maintained.
 23 However, a person may not be found liable for inadequate maintenance or destruction

1 of a best management practice if it were caused by an act of nature that could not
2 reasonably be anticipated by the person.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2005.
