CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Higher Education - Regional Centers - Approval to Operate in Maryland**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Maryland Higher Education Commission to
4 approve the operation of regional higher education centers in the State under
5 certain circumstances; requiring the Commission to assure that certain courses
6 and programs offered by regional higher education centers satisfy certain
7 criteria; altering a certain definition; and generally relating to the operation of
8 regional higher education centers in the State.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Education**

17 10-101.

18 (k) "Regional higher education center" means a higher education facility in the
19 State that:

20 (1) [Includes] IS OPERATED BY A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
21 EDUCATION IN THE STATE OR A NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION

1 OPERATING UNDER A CHARTER GRANTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND
2 INCLUDES participation by two or more institutions of higher education in the State;

3 (2) Consists of an array of program offerings FROM INSTITUTIONS OF
4 HIGHER EDUCATION APPROVED TO OPERATE IN THE STATE BY THE COMMISSION OR
5 BY AN ACT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY THAT SPECIFICALLY SATISFIES THE
6 CRITERIA SET FORTH IN § 10-212(B) OF THIS TITLE;

7 (3) Offers multiple degree levels; and

8 (4) Is either [affiliated with an institution of higher education]
9 APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION TO OPERATE IN THE STATE or is established by
10 statute.

12 (b) (7) The Commission HAS AUTHORITY TO APPROVE REGIONAL HIGHER
13 EDUCATION CENTERS TO OPERATE IN THE STATE AND has statewide coordinating
14 responsibility for regional higher education centers.

15 (d) (1) (I) THE COMMISSION MAY APPROVE REGIONAL HIGHER
16 EDUCATION CENTERS TO OPERATE IN THE STATE; AND

17 (II) With respect to the regional higher education centers, the
18 Commission:

19 [(i)] 1. May require submission of strategic plans in accordance
20 with guidelines adopted by the Commission;

21 [(ii)] 2. May provide grants to regional higher education centers
22 for ongoing operating expenses and lease payments if consistent with the State Plan
23 for Higher Education and the approved mission statements of the regional higher
24 education centers;

25 [(iii)] 3. Shall administer programs of State support and financial
26 assistance for the regional higher education centers;

27 [(iv)] 4. Shall assure that courses and programs offered are within
28 the scope of the approved missions of the regional higher education centers AND
29 SPECIFICALLY SATISFY THE CRITERIA SET FORTH IN § 10-212(B) OF THIS ARTICLE;
30 and

31 [(v)] 5. Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection,
32 shall assure that State funds for the regional higher education centers are spent
33 prudently and in accordance with State guidelines.

34 (2) With respect to the regional higher education centers administered
35 by the University System of Maryland, the University System of Maryland shall
36 assure that State funds for the regional higher education centers are spent prudently
37 and in accordance with State guidelines.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
2 effect July 1, 2005.
