18 19	(k) "Regional higher education center" means a higher education facility in the State that:
20 21	(1) [Includes] IS OPERATED BY A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE OR A NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION
