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1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 2 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article - State Finance and Procurement

5 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A LOAN THAT IS OUTSTANDING ON 6 JUNE 30, 2005.

7 (B) THE STATE TREASURER MAY NOT USE A FINANCIAL INSTITUTION AS A
8 DEPOSITARY UNLESS THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION CERTIFIES, IN WRITING, THAT
9 THE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION HAS NO DIRECT LOANS AND NO FOREKNOWLEDGE OF
10 ANY INDIRECT LOANS OUTSTANDING TO A GOVERNMENTAL UNIT OR NATIONAL
11 CORPORATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SUDAN.

12 (C) IF DIRECT OR INDIRECT LOANS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS
13 SECTION ARE MADE BY A FOREIGN OR OUT-OF-STATE FINANCIAL INSTITUTION
14 WITHOUT THE PARTICIPATION OF A SUBSIDIARY OR AFFILIATED CORPORATION,

19 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "DOING BUSINESS WITH OR IN THE REPUBLIC OF 20 SUDAN" MEANS:

21 (1) HAVING IN THE REPUBLIC ANY OPERATIONS OR A
22 MAJORITY-OWNED SUBSIDIARY THAT EMPLOYS MORE THAN 20 EMPLOYEES;

(2) PROVIDING FINANCIAL SERVICES TO THE GOVERNMENT OF THE
 24 REPUBLIC, INCLUDING PROVIDING DIRECT LOANS, UNDERWRITING GOVERNMENT
 25 SECURITIES, OR PROMOTING THE SALE OF GOLD COINS FROM THE REPUBLIC; OR

26 (3) PROVIDING ANY SUPPLIES OR SERVICES TO THE GOVERNMENT OF
27 THE REPUBLIC EXCEPT FOR SUPPLIES OR SERVICES PROVIDED FOR AN

(B) IN THIS SUBTITLE, "DOING BUSINESS WITH OR IN THE REPUBLIC OF
SUDAN" DOES NOT INCLUDE COMPLETING A LIMITED CONSULTING CONTRACT IN
EXISTENCE ON JULY 1, 2005, IN THE REPUBLIC THAT WAS ENTERED INTO AS A
RESULT OF THE COMPANY DIVESTING ITSELF OF ALL BUSINESS PROPERTY AND
OPERATIONS IN THE REPUBLIC.

A UNIT MAY NOT KNOWINGLY BUY FINISHED SUPPLIES THAT ARE PRODUCEDIN THE REPUBLIC OF SUDAN.

FOR A PROCUREMENT SOLICITED AFTER JULY 1, 2005, AND COSTING MORE
THAN \$100,000, THE BIDDER OR OFFEROR SHALL CERTIFY AT THE TIME THE
PROCUREMENT CONTRACT IS AWARDED THAT THE BIDDER OR OFFEROR IS NOT
DOING BUSINESS WITH OR IN THE REPUBLIC OF SUDAN OR KNOWINGLY
SUBCONTRACTING WITH AN ENTITY THAT DOES SO.

6 EXISTENCE ON JULY 1, 2005, IN THE REPUBLIC THAT WAS ENTERED INTO AS A
7 RESULT OF THE COMPANY DIVESTING ITSELF OF ALL BUSINESS PROPERTY AND
8 OPERATIONS IN THE REPUBLIC.

9 (3) AN EXTERNAL INVESTMENT MANAGER SELECTED BY THE BOARD OF
10 TRUSTEES MAY NOT INVEST ANY FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE MANAGER IN ANY

13(4)THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SHALL INCLUDE THE REQUIREMENT14UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION IN THE INVESTMENT POLICY MANUAL.
