BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 15 **Article - Real Property** 16 8A-1001. 17 Within 45 days after the end of the tenancy, the park owner shall 18 return the security deposit to the resident together with simple interest which has 19 accrued in the amount of [4] 3 percent per annum less any damages rightfully 20 withheld. 21 Interest shall accrue at 6-month intervals from the day the resident 22 gives the park owner the security deposit. Interest is not compounded. 23 (3)Interest shall be payable only on security deposits of \$50 or more. 24 If the park owner, without a reasonable basis, fails to return any part

25 of the security deposit, plus accrued interest, within 45 days after the termination of 26 the tenancy, the resident has an action of up to threefold of the withheld amount, plus

27 reasonable attorney's fees.

- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be
- 2 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have
- 3 any effect on or application to any mobile home park tenancy created or renewed
- 4 before the effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2005.
