There is a Class BLX (luxury restaurant) (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor 17 18 license IN HOWARD COUNTY. This license may only be issued for the use of a 19 restaurant: 20 In which there is a minimum capital investment of \$750,000 for (1) 21 restaurant facilities, exclusive of the cost of land and buildings;

- 1 (2) The construction of which commenced on or after July 1, 1992; and
- 2 (3) That has a minimum seating capacity of 125 persons.
- 3 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of § 9-102(a) of this article, a Class BLX
- 4 (luxury restaurant) (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license may be issued to an
- 5 applicant that already holds a valid Class B (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license or
- 6 a valid Class BLX (luxury restaurant) (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license.
- 7 (c) A Class BLX (luxury restaurant) (on-sale) beer, wine and liquor license 8 may be issued to an applicant that does not hold any other liquor license.
- 9 (d) The annual fee for a Class BLX (luxury restaurant) (on-sale) beer, wine 10 and liquor license is \$2,000.00.
