13 who holds office between June 1, 2005 and January 9, 2007. The provisions of Section14 2 of this Act relating to the powers, duties, responsibilities, and compensation of the

15 Commissioner are intended to apply to the elected Commissioner.

16 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall 17 take effect July 1, 2006.
