4 FOR the purpose of exempting in Charles County holders of Class B or Class C
5 alcoholic beverages licenses from the prohibition against selling alcoholic
6 beverages at a bar or counter on Sunday; and generally relating to alcoholic

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

21 11-403.

22 (a) (1) A retail dealer holding a Class B or C license may not sell any
23 alcoholic beverage at a bar or counter on Sunday.

24 (10) THE PROHIBITION SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS
25 SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY IN CHARLES COUNTY.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 July 1, 2005.
