	(A) (1) A NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RESIDENTS WHO LIVE WITHIN A 1-MILE RADIUS OF THE INSTITUTION'S CAMPUS TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY RELATIONS COUNCIL.
	(2) ON COMPLETION OF THE AGREEMENT, THE INSTITUTION SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE COMMISSION THAT INCLUDES THE DATE ON WHICH THE AGREEMENT WAS ENTERED AND A SUMMARY OF THE AGREEMENT.

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(B) THE PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT IS TO SAFEGUARD THE RESIDENTIAL

(D) A NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT DOES NOT
ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION IS NOT ELIGIBLE
TO RECEIVE FUNDING FROM THE STATE FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS.

THE STATE MAY NOT EXPEND FUNDS FOR A CAPITAL PROJECT FOR A
NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE UNTIL THE
NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION:

(1) ENTERS INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH RESIDENTS WHO LIVE WITHIN A
1-MILE RADIUS OF THE NONPUBLIC INSTITUTION'S CAMPUS TO CREATE A
COMMUNITY RELATIONS COUNCIL AS PROVIDED UNDER § 17-108 OF THIS SUBTITLE;
AND

32 (2) SUBMITS A REPORT CONTAINING THE DATE AND A SUMMARY OF THE 33 AGREEMENT UNDER § 17-108 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
