A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Charles County - Education - Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps**
3 **Instructors**

4 FOR the purpose of including Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC)
5 instructors in the definition of "public school employees" for the purpose of
6 certain provisions of law related to organizations of certificated employees; and
7 generally relating to representation for JROTC instructors in Charles County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 6-401.

17 (d) (1) "Public school employee" means a certificated professional individual
18 who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in
19 Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the
20 public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6-408(b) of
21 this subtitle.

22 (2) In Montgomery County, "public school employees" include:

23 (i) Certificated and noncertificated substitute teachers employed
24 by the public school employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal
25 year ending June 30, 1978, and each year after; and

26 (ii) Home and hospital teachers employed by the public school
27 employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal year ending June 30,
28 2000, and each year after.

1 (3) In Baltimore County, "public school employee" includes:

2 (i) A secondary school nurse, an elementary school nurse, and a
3 special school nurse; and

4 (ii) Supervisory noncertificated employees as defined under §
5 6-501(h) of this title.

6 (4) In Frederick County, "public school employee" includes a social
7 worker employed by a public school employer.

8 (5) In Prince George's County, "public school employee" includes home
9 and hospital teachers and [junior reserve officer training] JUNIOR RESERVE
10 OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) instructors.

11 (6) IN CHARLES COUNTY, "PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE" INCLUDES
12 JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) INSTRUCTORS.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
14 October 1, 2005.
