AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be 35 construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have 36 any effect on or application to any cause of action arising before the effective date of 37 this Act.

- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2005.
