THERE IS A JOINT COMMITTEE ON ACCESS TO MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES. 5 (B) 6 (C) (1) THE COMMITTEE CONSISTS OF EIGHT MEMBERS. 7 OF THE EIGHT MEMBERS: (2) 8 (I) FOUR SHALL BE SENATORS, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT; 9 AND 10 (II) FOUR SHALL BE DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER. 11 (3) OF THE FOUR SENATORS: TWO SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE FINANCE COMMITTEE: 12 (I) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE BUDGET AND TAXATION 13 (II)14 COMMITTEE; AND 15 ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE EDUCATION, HEALTH, AND (III) 16 ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE. OF THE FOUR DELEGATES: 17 (4) 18 TWO SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE HEALTH AND GOVERNMENT 19 OPERATIONS COMMITTEE; ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE APPROPRIATIONS 20 (II)21 COMMITTEE; AND 22 (III) ONE SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE ECONOMIC MATTERS 23 COMMITTEE. THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE 24 (D) 25 PRESIDING OFFICER WHO APPOINTED THEM. FROM AMONG THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE COMMITTEE. THE 26 (E) (1) 27 PRESIDENT SHALL APPOINT A SENATOR TO SERVE AS THE SENATE CHAIR OF THE 28 COMMITTEE, AND THE SPEAKER SHALL APPOINT A DELEGATE TO SERVE AS THE 29 HOUSE CHAIR OF THE COMMITTEE. 30 THE SENATE CHAIR AND THE HOUSE CHAIR SHALL ALTERNATE (2)
