- 1 (ii) \$1,000 shall be placed into a capital account by the Tylerton
- 2 Volunteer Fire Company, and shall be used only for capital expenditures, such as
- 3 purchasing, operating, and repairing fire apparatus and equipment.
- 4 (2) Payments may not be made to any company which has any
- 5 regulations or resolutions limiting the territory within which it will respond to calls.
- 6 (c) Each fire company receiving County funds shall provide an accounting of 7 the expenditures of the funds to the County Commissioners.
- 8 (d) The County Commissioners may levy for and appropriate funds annually
- 9 for emergency services provided by any volunteer fire company or rescue squad if the
- 10 volunteer fire company or rescue squad is operated on a not for profit basis.
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 July 1, 2005.
