(C) (1) THE GOVERNING BODY OF CARROLL COUNTY MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A
PROPERTY TAX CREDIT AGAINST THE COUNTY PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON REAL
PROPERTY OWNED BY CERTAIN CLASSES OF INDIVIDUALS, AS SPECIFIED BY THE
GOVERNING BODY OF CARROLL COUNTY, WHO ARE AT LEAST 65 YEARS OLD AND
WHO ARE OF LIMITED INCOME.
