A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County Board of Education - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the president and members of the
4 Washington County Board of Education; providing that this Act does not apply
5 to the salary or compensation of an incumbent president or member of the
6 Washington County Board of Education; and generally relating to the salary of
7 the president and members of the Washington County Board of Education.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Education**

16 3-1302.

17 (a) (1) The president of the County Board is entitled to receive [\$4,900]
18 \$5,600 annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive
19 [\$4,800] \$5,500 each annually as compensation. This compensation is to be paid in 12
20 equal monthly installments.

21 (2) Each member of the Washington County Board of Education is
22 entitled to health insurance and to other fringe benefits regularly provided to
23 employees of the Board of Education.

24 (b) After submitting vouchers, members shall be reimbursed for travel and
25 other expenses within the limit set by the Washington County Commissioners.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
27 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
28 the salary or compensation of the president or members of the Washington County

1 Board of Education in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this
2 Act concerning the salary or compensation of the president and members of the
3 Washington County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next
4 following term of office.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
6 October 1, 2005.
