- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the president and members of the
- 4 Washington County Board of Education; providing that this Act does not apply
- 5 to the salary or compensation of an incumbent president or member of the
- Washington County Board of Education; and generally relating to the salary of
- 7 the president and members of the Washington County Board of Education.

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article Education
- 16 3-1302.
- 17 (a) (1) The president of the County Board is entitled to receive [\$4,900]
- 18 \$5,600 annually as compensation and the other members are entitled to receive
- 19 [\$4,800] \$5,500 each annually as compensation. This compensation is to be paid in 12
- 20 equal monthly installments.
- 21 (2) Each member of the Washington County Board of Education is
- 22 entitled to health insurance and to other fringe benefits regularly provided to
- 23 employees of the Board of Education.
- 24 (b) After submitting vouchers, members shall be reimbursed for travel and
- 25 other expenses within the limit set by the Washington County Commissioners.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, §
- 27 35 of the Maryland Constitution, this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to
- 28 the salary or compensation of the president or members of the Washington County

- 1 Board of Education in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this
- 2 Act concerning the salary or compensation of the president and members of the
- 3 Washington County Board of Education shall take effect at the beginning of the next
- 4 following term of office.
- 5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 6 October 1, 2005.
