- 20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 (L) EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST
- 25 \$250,000,000 IN THE STATE BUDGET OR THE CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOAN

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- 1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland 2 read as follows:

- 4 5-301.
- 5 (K) EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST
- 6 \$250,000,000 IN THE STATE BUDGET OR THE CONSOLIDATED CAPITAL BOND LOAN
- 7 FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION.
- 8 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall
- 9 take effect June 1, 2005. It shall remain effective for a period of 8 years, or until the
- 10 taking effect of Section 2 of this Act, whichever occurs first. At the end of June 30,
- 11 2012, or if Section 2 of this Act takes effect, with no further action required by the
- 12 General Assembly, Section 1 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and
- 13 effect.
- 14 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 2 of this Act shall
- 15 take effect July 1, 2005, the effective date of Section 2 of Chapters 306 and 307 of the
- 16 Acts of the General Assembly of 2004. If the effective date of Chapters 306 and 307 is
- 17 amended, Section 2 of this Act shall take effect on the taking effect of Chapter 306 and
- 18 307. Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective until the end of June 30, 2012, and,
- 19 with no further action required by the General Assembly, Section 2 of this Act shall be
- 20 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
