

- 1 (16) In Allegany County, designating crossings on county highways where 2 a person operating a golf cart may cross the highway for continued access to any 3 portion of a golf course.
- 4 (b) (1) Unless it first obtains written approval from the State Highway 5 Administration, a local authority may not place or maintain any stop sign or traffic 6 control signal that requires the traffic on any State highway to stop before entering or 7 crossing any intersecting highway.
- 8 (2) Unless it first obtains written permission from the State Highway 9 Administration, a local authority may not place or maintain lighting along or at an 10 intersection with a State highway.
- 11 (c) An ordinance or regulation adopted under items (4), (5), (6), (7), or (10) of 12 subsection (a) of this section is not effective until a traffic control device giving notice 13 of the local traffic regulations is placed on or at the entrances to the highway or its 14 affected part.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 2005.
