A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Prince George's County - Parent and Community Advisory Board**
3 **PG 413-05**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of members of the Parent and Community
5 Advisory Board in Prince George's County; altering the composition of the
6 Advisory Board; requiring the New Prince George's County Board of Education
7 or certain designated Board members and the Chief Executive Officer of the
8 New Prince George's County Board of Education to meet and consult with the
9 Advisory Board and ensure parental involvement in the development and
10 implementation of policies and procedures regarding certain school system's
11 budgets and the school system's master plan; requiring the Chief Executive
12 Officer to meet with the Advisory Board a certain number of times each year;
13 authorizing the replacement of certain Advisory Board members who have more
14 than a certain number of unexcused absences in a year; requiring the Prince
15 George's County school system to provide staff for the Advisory Board; requiring
16 the Advisory Board to post a certain agenda on a certain website a certain
17 number of days before a certain meeting; requiring the Advisory Board to post
18 certain minutes on a certain website within a certain number of days after a
19 certain meeting; and generally relating to the Prince George's County Parent
20 and Community Advisory Board.

26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 **Article - Education**

2 4-406.

3 (a) (1) There is a Parent and Community Advisory Board in the Prince
4 George's County public school system.

5 (2) The Advisory Board consists of [13 members, a majority of whom
6 shall be parents of students enrolled in the Prince George's County public schools.

7 (3) Subject to the approval of the Board, the Chief Executive Officer
8 shall appoint the 13 members of the Advisory Board as follows]:

9 (I) THE FOLLOWING FIVE MEMBERS:

10 1. TWO MEMBERS OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY
11 SENATE DELEGATION, APPOINTED JOINTLY BY THE CHAIRMAN OF PRINCE GEORGE'S
12 COUNTY SENATE DELEGATION AND CHAIRMAN OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY
13 HOUSE DELEGATION;

14 2. TWO MEMBERS OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HOUSE
15 DELEGATION, APPOINTED JOINTLY BY THE CHAIRMAN OF PRINCE GEORGE'S
16 COUNTY SENATE DELEGATION AND CHAIRMAN OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY
17 HOUSE DELEGATION; AND

18 3. ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OF
19 PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY; AND

20 (II) THE FOLLOWING 10 MEMBERS, APPOINTED JOINTLY BY THE
21 PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY SENATE DELEGATION AND THE PRINCE GEORGE'S
22 COUNTY HOUSE DELEGATION:

23 [(i)] 1. [Five shall be appointed] TWO REPRESENTATIVES from a
24 list submitted by the Prince George's County Council of Parent-Teacher Associations;

25 [(ii)] 2. [Two shall be appointed] ONE REPRESENTATIVE from a
26 list submitted by the [Committee of 100] PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY TALENTED AND
27 GIFTED;

28 [(iii)] 3. [Three shall be appointed] TWO REPRESENTATIVES from
29 a list submitted by the [Title I liaisons] PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY COUNCIL; [and

30 [(iv)] 4. [Three shall be appointed] ONE REPRESENTATIVE from a
31 list submitted by [other parent and community groups in Prince George's County]
32 THE NAACP, PRINCE GEORGE'S CHAPTER;

33 5. ONE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PRINCE GEORGE'S
34 COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE;

35 6. ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM A LIST SUBMITTED BY THE
36 ARC OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY;
