4 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum number of Class B (beer and light wine),
 5 Class B (beer, wine and liquor), and Class BH (beer, wine and liquor) licenses
 6 authorized to be issued in Prince George's County; and generally relating to
 7 alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

21 9-217.

22 (a) This section applies only in Prince George's County.

23 (b) The number of licenses of each class of alcoholic beverage licenses may not
 24 exceed the following maximum amounts:

25 (6) Beer and light wine license, Class B [38] 45

1 (12) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class B [170] 185

2 (15) Beer, wine and liquor license, Class BH [20] 25

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 2005.
