5 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class D beer, wine and liquor license in Prince George's County; establishing an annual license fee; requiring the premises that is the subject of the license application to meet certain requirements; requiring certain applicants for a Class D beer, wine and liquor license to surrender a certain license when the Class D beer, wine and liquor license is issued; prohibiting certain persons from being on the licensed premises; allowing a person to offer entertainment at a licensed premises only with the prior approval of the Board of License Commissioners; requiring the Board of License Commissioners to adopt certain regulations; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners to issue a certain number of Class D beer, wine and liquor licenses; and generally relating to Class D beer, wine and liquor licenses in Prince George's County.

(3) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$4,000.
