2 **Prince George's County - Class B-MB/22 Alcoholic Beverages License**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B-MB/22 license in a certain legislative
 5 district of Prince George's County; authorizing the Class B-MB/22 license to be
 6 issued only to certain persons; setting an annual fee; authorizing the holder of
 7 both a Class B-MB/22 license and a certain micro-brewery license to hold a
 8 certain additional license; specifying that a Class B-MB/22 license holder is
 9 entitled to sell liquor under certain conditions; and generally relating to
 10 alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

3 (r) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

4 (14) (I) THERE IS A CLASS B-MB/22 LICENSE, WHICH MAY BE ISSUED
5 ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS 7 MICRO-BREWERY LICENSE IN THE 22ND
6 LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT.

7 (II) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$990.

8 (III) A CLASS B-MB/22 LICENSE ENTITLES THE HOLDER TO SELL
9 LIQUOR BY THE DRINK FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES ONLY.10 (IV) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE
11 HOLDER OF A CLASS B-MB/22 LICENSE MAY ALSO HOLD A CLASS D LICENSE.12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
13 June 1, 2005.
