2 **Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Minimum Investment for**
3 **Class BLX Licenses**
4 **PG 337-05**

5 FOR the purpose of increasing the minimum capital investment required for Class
6 BLX licenses issued for luxury type restaurants in Prince George's County; and
7 generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Prince George's County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

21 6-201.

22 (r) (1) (i) This subsection applies only in Prince George's County.

23 (6) (i) There is a Class BLX license, which is a special Class B license.

24 (ii) The annual license fee is \$2,750.

1 (iii) 1. Class BLX licenses may be issued only to luxury type
2 restaurants, a term which shall be defined by the regulations of the Board.

3 2. The restaurant shall have a minimum capital investment
4 of [\$800,000] \$1,000,000 for dining room facilities and kitchen equipment, which sum
5 may not include the cost of land, buildings or a lease.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 October 1, 2005.
